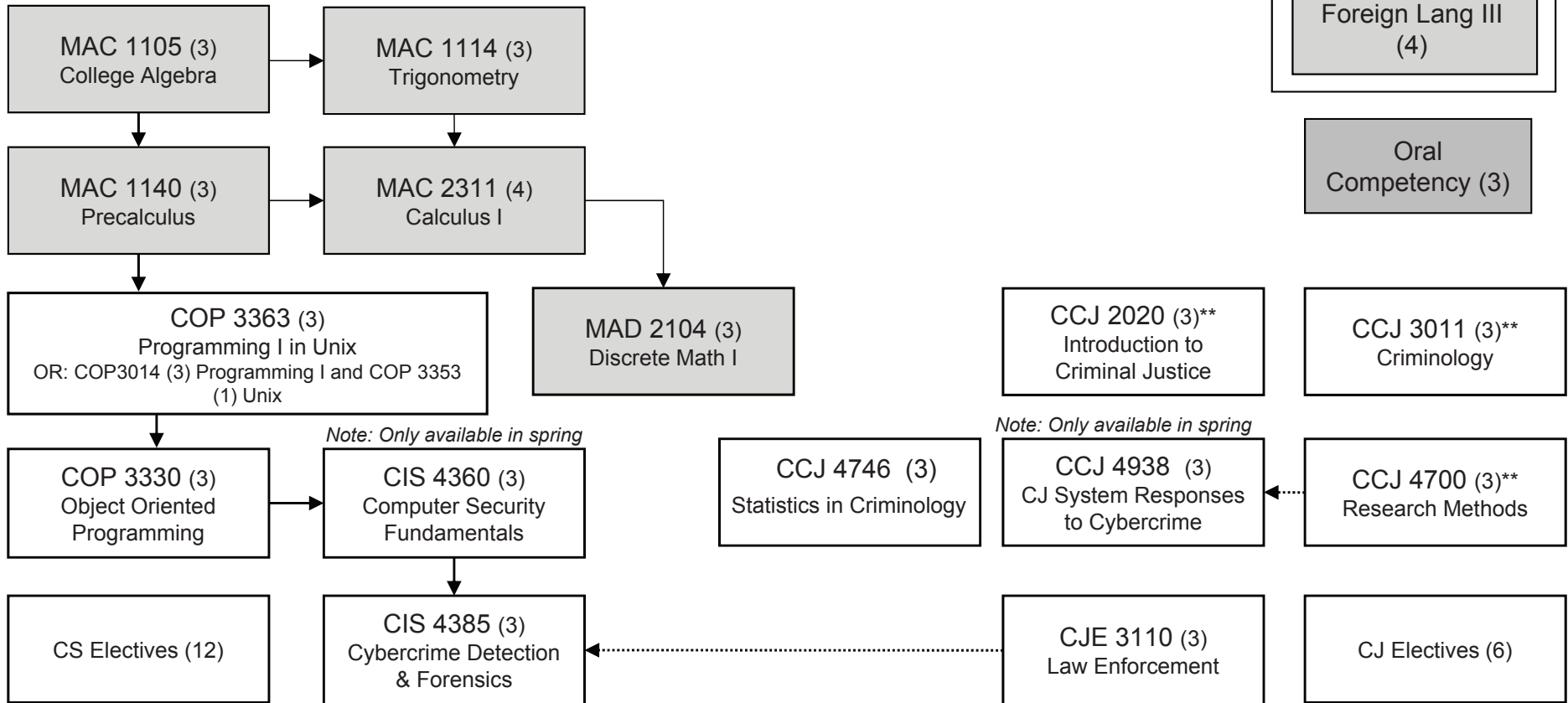


# Undergraduate Cyber Criminology Flowchart
